


Isolation quick guide
under 13s (1) 18.01.22

I am under 12 and a household contact – what do I do?

All under 12s restrict movements for 7 days, unless you have tested positive since 1 December 2021 and recovered

Children aged 9-12 should wear a well fitted mask for 10 days

Children aged 4-12 should take regular antigen tests, with the last test on day 7

Children under 3 should only take a PCR test if they are symptomatic

What do I do if I have a positive test result?

Isolate for 7 days

Ending of self-isolation after 7 days is on the basis that symptoms have substantially or fully resolved for the final 2 of those 7 days

It is okay to stop self-isolating after seven days even if you have a mild cough or changes to your sense of smell – these can last for weeks after the infection has gone

Anyone aged 13 and older use a well-fitted medical grade or FFP2 face mask for 7 days

Children aged 9-12 years should use a well fitted mask for 10 days

Tá Hepa filters i ngach seomra ranga & CO₂ monitors i ngach Seomra ranga.

Since returning last term, many schools are monitoring CO₂ as an indication of deteriorating air quality/poor ventilation. Elevated CO₂ levels (caused by people exhaling) are taken as a cue to ventilate the room, by opening windows. If the room is well ventilated the spread of COVID-19 will be reduced.

We now have CO₂ monitors and Hepa filters installed in every room in the school to improve air quality and protect both páistí and staff.

KANE'S KAMPAIGN & YOU

Kane was born prematurely at just 28 weeks! This was the scariest, saddest time of our lives but our little warrior fought his way through NICU and finally came home to us after 8 long weeks. Unfortunately, as he grew it became apparent he had progressing Cerebral Palsy and he was eventually diagnosed with spastic quad CP meaning he has stiff, tight muscles in all 4 limbs and he is unable to control his movement.

Kane's body is never at rest like ours. His muscles are constantly overworking and tightening. Kane also uses a lot more energy than us to overcome this spasticity to make any purposeful movements. His body is constantly being pulled in different directions affecting his ability to sit up right. All of this is exhausting, causes pain and puts him at risk of hip and back problems. Kane has shown the world that he has place in it, and now it's our turn to give him as much as we can in love, kindness and any resources you can - we want Kane to be able to participate in this world as much as possible. Unfortunately, we are fighting against those tight muscles and we are losing.

Where can you help? There is this life changing SDR surgery which permanently reduces spasticity. It will improve his comfort and his sitting and standing and walking. It is in the US it comes at a price.

We need your help to raise the funds to bring Kane to St Louis, MO, USA for the surgery and remain there for up to 5 weeks. On return home he will need a lot of physio and some home equipment to build up his muscle strength.
