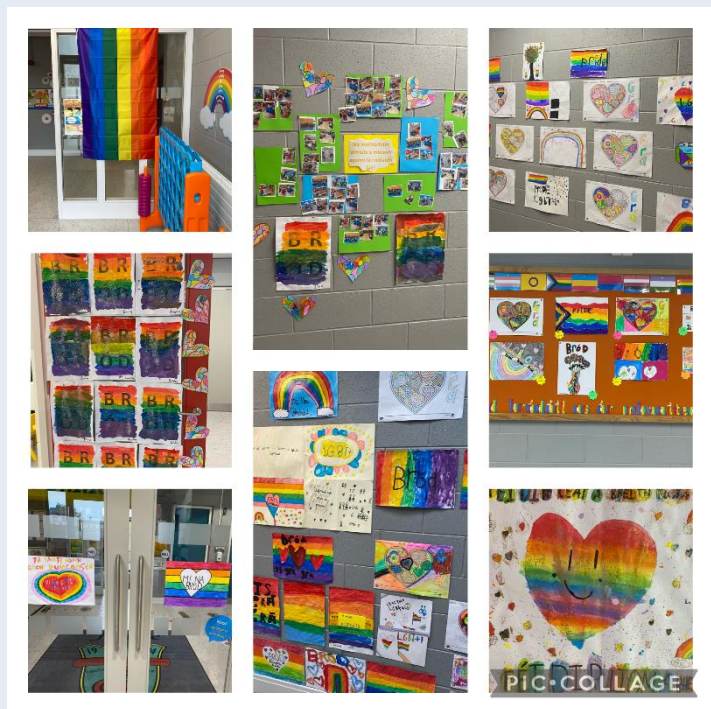




## Bród/Pride

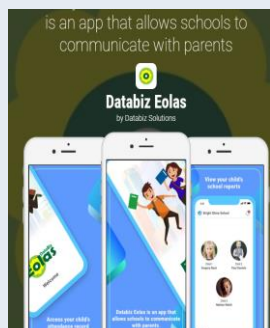
